By eliminating lock rekeying charges, your security operating costs are greatly reduced.

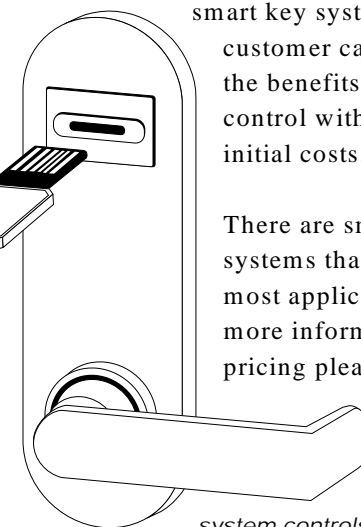
