How to Secure Your Home in Four Easy Steps

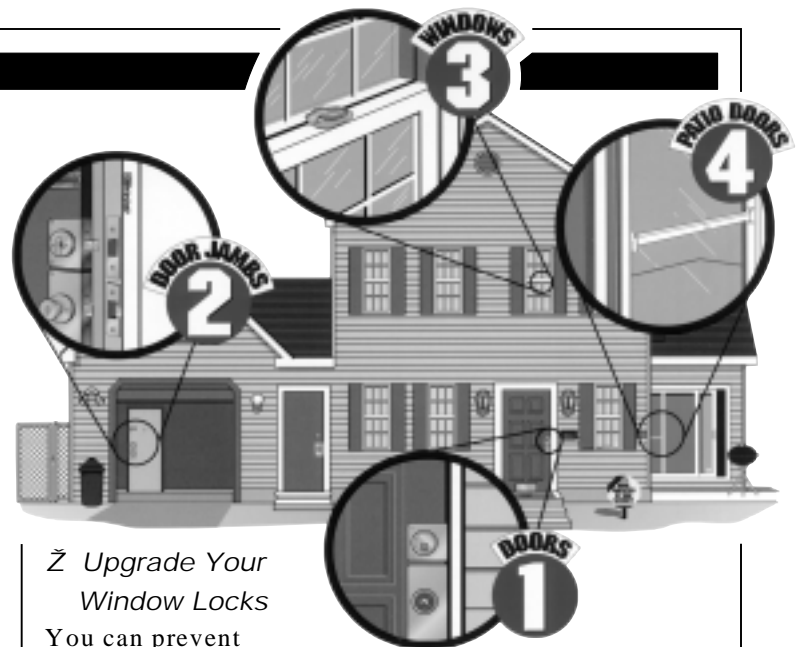
The best way to protect your home is to secure the most likely areas that a burglar might use to gain entry. Its easy, just follow these steps:

1. Secure Your Wood Doors

You can help prevent break-ins by more than doubling the strength of any door and lockset with metal "MAG Plate" door reinforcers. These plates resist prying and reduce the chance of damage to your door if a break-in is actually attempted.

- *Add Reinforced Strike Plates*

Your lock is only as good as the door jamb. A reinforced strike plate will prevent door kick-ins and provide added protection against door prying.



2. Upgrade Your Window Locks

You can prevent entry through your windows by installing upgraded locks on each of your double-hung windows.

- *Secure Your Patio Doors*

Sliding patio doors are quite vulnerable until you install after-market dead locks or patio door bars.
